Sts. Peter and Paul parish will celebrate its feast day on Saturday June 28 with mass at 6:00 pm followed by a meal. Please make plans to attend.

The Scripture lessons: The first reading gives an account of the event of the Ascension as recorded in the Acts of the Apostles. First, Jesus instructed his apostles to *remain in Jerusalem and wait for the baptism by the Holy Spirit* so that they might become his *"witnesses to the ends of the earth"* by the power of the Holy Spirit. Then *a cloud took Jesus from the sight* of the disciples and two Heavenly messengers in white garments gave them the assurance of Jesus' *"second coming"* or return in glory. In the second reading, Paul explains the theological meaning of Jesus' exaltation, giving us the assurance that one day, we, too, will be ascending to Heavenly Glory, provided we fulfill the mission entrusted to us by the ascending Lord. Today's Gospel describes how Jesus ascended to Heaven after giving his final blessing and missionary command to his disciples. The command was to *"proclaim the Good News to the whole creation," "to be his witnesses,"* and *"to make disciples of all nations."*
